Does The Bible Contain Errors Part 3

Critics of the Word of God have used Science to discredit the Bible for many years. They allege that Science and the Scripture are at odds with one another. However this could not be farther from the truth. Science and Scripture are in harmony, not in dispute. The Bible declares what took men centuries to discover. In 1492 Christopher Columbus with the financial backing of Queen Isabella and King Ferdinand, set sail westward to the Orient with three ships, the Nina, Pinta, and the Santa Maria. Columbus knew the earth was round, but some of his critics thought the earth was flat. Isaiah wrote hundreds of years before Columbus made his voyage, *"It is he that sitteth upon the circle of the earth, and the inhabitants thereof are as grasshoppers; that stretcheth out the heavens as a curtain, and spreadeth them out as a tent to dwell in"* (Isaiah 40:22). If, by chance, there were those today who would doubt the fact the earth is a circle or more exact a sphere, NASA space explorations have sent pictures of the earth back from outer space showing that it definitely is not flat. Again, the Bible told us, *"He stretcheth out the north over the empty place, and hangeth the earth upon nothing"* (Job 26:7).

In the late 16th or early 17th century, scientist discovered what is known as a complete water cycle. The Mississippi River dumps 6,052,500 gallons of water into the Gulf of Mexico every second. Where does it go? It recycles. *"All the rivers run into the sea. Yet the sea is not full To the place from which the rivers come, There they return again"* (Ecclesiastes 1:7). *"If the clouds are full of rain, They empty themselves upon the earth"* (Ecclesiastes 11:3). *"He who builds His layers in the sky, And has founded His strata in the earth; Who calls for the waters of the sea, And pours them out on the face of the earth—The LORD is His name"* (Amos 9:6).

Enemies of the Bible often claim that the Bible contradicts itself. The Bible says *"And God saw every thing that he had made, and, behold, it was very good. And the evening and the morning were the sixth day"* (Genesis 1:31). A few chapters later in the first book of the Bible these words are found, *"And God saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually"* (Genesis 6:5). The critics say, "gotcha" but a well informed student of the Bible recognizes a time difference. You may read that Bill Dedmon is 6 feet tall and weighs 150 pounds. A quick look sends up a red flag. Bill is still 6 foot tall but closer to 250 pounds. A contradiction? No, just about 40 years difference. There is a time difference in Genesis chapters one and five, not a discrepancy.
