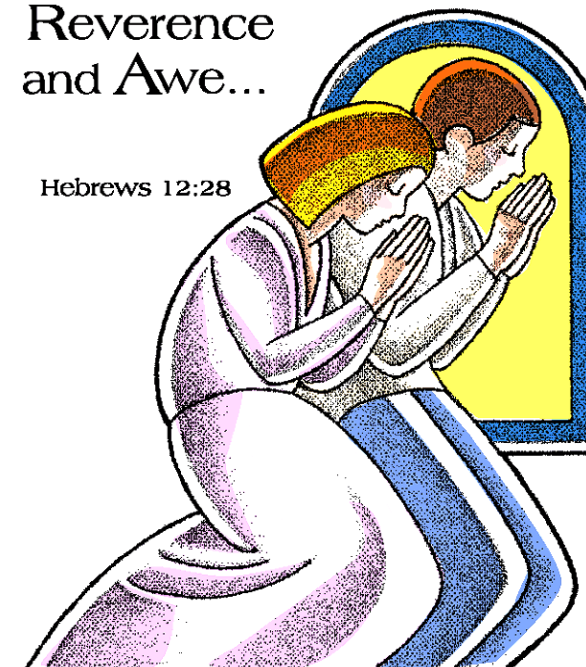

GOD'S CARE
